


THE SUPER FAN

A JESUS SUPERFAN!

- The Jesus SuperFan:
 - Knows as much as they can about Jesus
 - Doesn't hide their love for Him
 - 'Wears His clothes' puts on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering, ...
 ... and LOVE!
 - Follows His example in their lives
 - Actively works to see others become fans too!

WORSHIP – AS A LIFESTYLE

- We are new people in Christ
 - We have a lot to be grateful for!
- Expressing worship through our lives actively changes us and affects other people
- It is not automatic but conscious decisions every day
- Here are some examples...

PROVERBS 3:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct^[a] your paths.

Worship: Trust God in every situation... despite what your mind and the world says!

PROVERBS 3:7-8 (NKJV)

⁷ Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil. ⁸ It will be health to your flesh, [b] And strength [c] to your bones.

Worship: Yes you know what to do, but check with God first anyway. Avoid things God hates

PROVERBS 3:9-10 (NKJV)

⁹ Honor the LORD with your possessions, And with the firstfruits of all your increase; ¹⁰ So your barns will be filled with plenty, And your vats will overflow with new wine.

Worship: See your earthly stuff and money as God's Love Him by sharing (wisely) with others

PROVERBS 3:9-12 (NKJV)

¹¹ My son, do not despise the chastening of the LORD, Nor detest His correction;

¹² For whom the LORD loves He corrects, Just as a father the son *in whom* he delights.

Worship: Be humble to admit you are wrong sometimes Repent and return to His way
