**Going home**





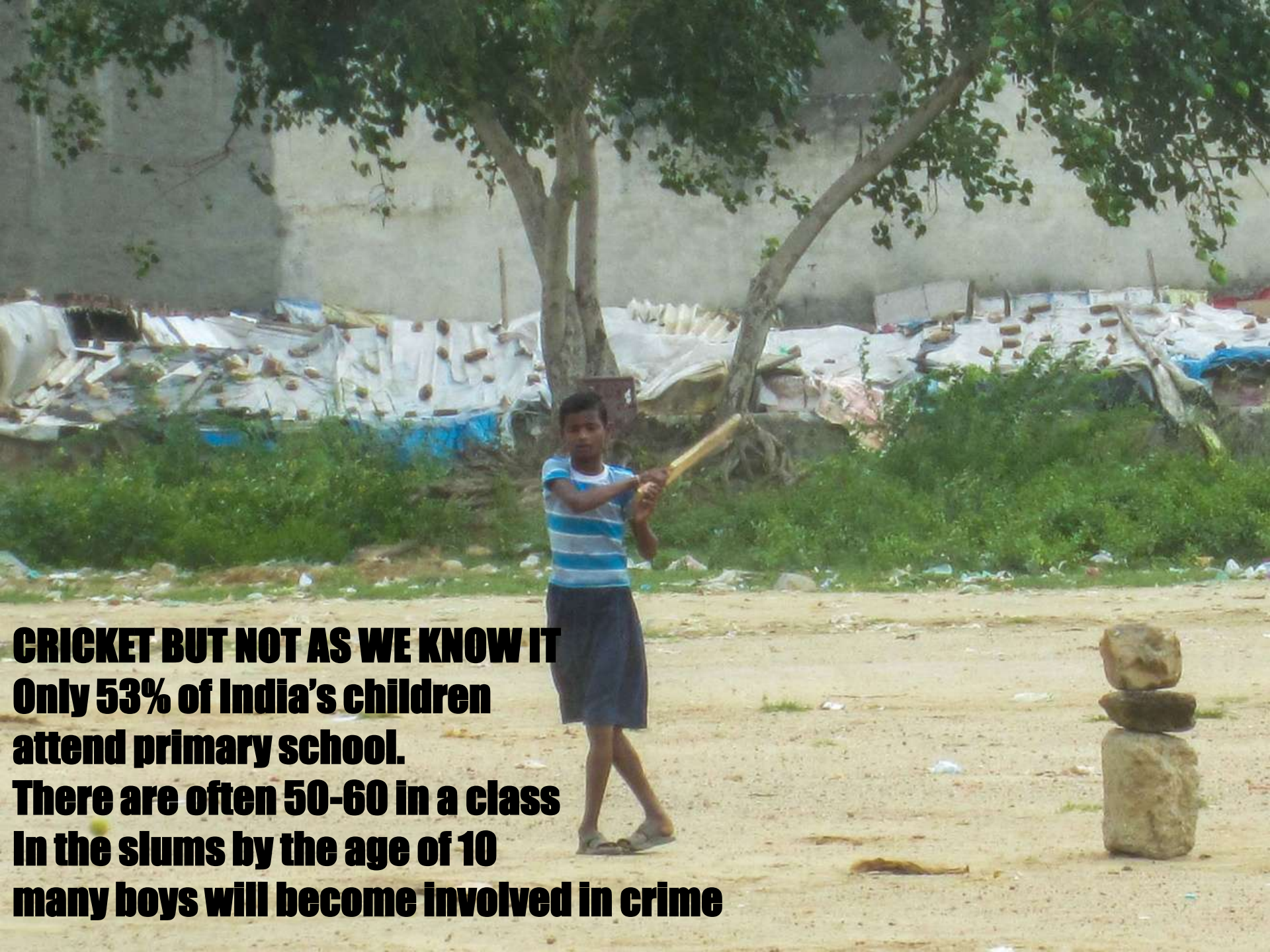




**One of India's 480 million children  
40% of India's population is under 18  
9.5% do not see their 5<sup>th</sup> birthday**



**58% below the age of 2 are not fully immunised**  
**More than 50% of India's children are malnourished**



**CRICKET BUT NOT AS WE KNOW IT**  
**Only 53% of India's children**  
**attend primary school.**  
**There are often 50-60 in a class**  
**In the slums by the age of 10**  
**many boys will become involved in crime**

**No public services such as rubbish collection  
No covered sewers**

'Right to roam'.**



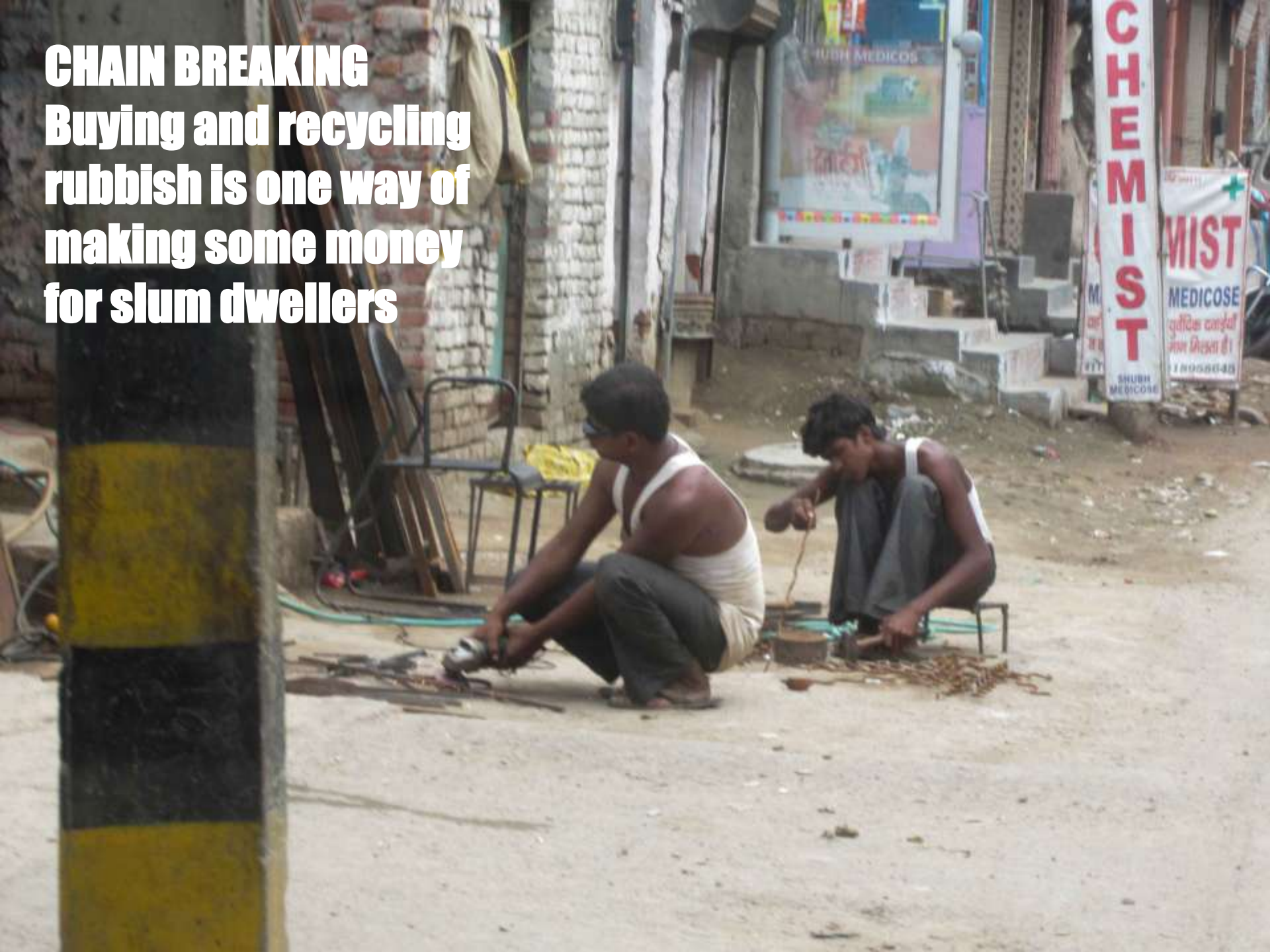
